Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 945 "THE ADULT AND LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY RESIDENT MALTREATMENT ACT."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 945.

Amend Senate Bill No. 945 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 33 through 36

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 and substitute the following: "(3) Provide for a civil action, if appropriate, to protect maltreated adults and residents of long-term care facilities; and (4) Encourage the cooperation of state law enforcement officials, courts, and state agencies in the investigation, assessment, and prosecution of maltreated adults and residents of long-term care facilities."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 11 and 12 and substitute the following: "person would believe subjects an endangered or impaired person, regardless of age, ability to comprehend, or disability, to ridicule or"

AND

Page 6, delete line 21 and substitute the following: "result of a civil action under this"

AND

Page 7, delete lines 19 through 36

AND

Page 8, delete lines 1 through 6 and substitute the following: "(d)(1) A report of an allegation of suspected adult or long-term care facility resident maltreatment shall be accepted if the allegation, if true, would constitute adult or long-term care facility resident maltreatment and as long as sufficient identifying information is provided to identify and



locate the victim.

- (2) Reports to the hotline when the allegations, even if true, would not constitute adult or long-term care facility resident maltreatment shall be screened out.
- (e)(1) The hotline shall accept a report if the victim or offender is present in Arkansas or if the incident occurred in Arkansas.
- (2) If the incident occurred in another state, the hotline shall screen out the report and transfer the report to the hotline of the state in which the incident occurred.
- (3) Upon request from an adult or long-term care facility resident maltreatment investigator in another state, the department shall complete courtesy interviews with the victim, offender, or any witness of adult maltreatment who reside in Arkansas.
- (f) Upon registration of a hotline report of suspected adult or long-term care facility resident maltreatment, the hotline shall refer the matter immediately to the appropriate investigating agency as outlined in this subchapter."

AND

Page 11, delete lines 4 through 7 and substitute the following:

"(B) All cases of suspected adult maltreatment of an endangered or impaired adult if a family member is named as the suspected offender, regardless of whether or not the endangered or impaired adult resides in a long-term care facility."

AND

Page 14, delete lines 18 through 24 and substitute the following:

"(i)(a) The person identified as the offender.

(b) However, in cases of unfounded self-

neglect, no notice is required;

(ii) The person identified as the maltreated person; (iii) The legal guardian of the maltreated person;

or

(iv) The natural or legal guardian of a long-term care facility resident under eighteen (18) years of age;"

AND

Page 19, delete lines 8 through 15 and substitute the following: "services needed by the maltreated person; and

(13) Any applicable licensing or registering authority."

AND

Page 20, delete lines 23 through 30 and substitute the following: "having services needed by the maltreated person; and

(H) Any applicable licensing or registering authority."

AND

Page 21, delete line 13 and substitute the following:	
"or grand jury; and"	
AND	
Page 21, delete lines 15 through 20 and substitute the following:	
"services needed by the person."
