Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 95.

Amend Senate Bill No. 95 as originally introduced:

Immediately following SECTION 1, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-10-703(c), pertaining to contributions, is amended to read as follows:

(c)(1) Seventy-five percent (75%) For members that have at least twenty-eight (28) years of service before electing to participate in the Local Police and Fire Deferred Retirement Option Plan, seventy-five percent (75%) of the member's monthly retirement benefit that would have been payable had the member elected to cease employment and receive a service retirement shall be paid into the members' plan account.

(2) For members that have at least twenty (20) but less than twenty-eight (28) years of service and are at least fifty-five (55) years of age before electing to participate in the Local Police and Fire Deferred Retirement Option Plan, seventy-four and ninety-five one-hundredths percent (74.95%) of the member's monthly retirement benefit that would have been payable had the member elected to cease employment and receive a service retirement shall be paid into the members' plan account."
