Page 2, delete lines 10 through 18 and substitute the following: "subdivisions (2)(A)(ii)(a)-(e) of this section.

(B) 'Broadband technology' includes, but is not limited

to:

- (i) Asynchronous transfer mode switches;
- (ii) Routers;
- (iii) Servers;
- (iv) Multiplexers;
- (v) Fiber optics; and
- (vi) Equipment related to the items listed in

subdivisions (B)(i)-(vi) of this section;"



Page 3, line 20, delete "after" and substitute "six"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 22 through 24 and substitute the following: "(d) If the tax credit for any tax year exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the income tax liability for that year, the unused portions may be carried forward for six (6) tax years following the tax year in which the credit was earned."

Page 4, delete line 9 and substitute the following:
"(a) The gross receipts or gross proceeds from sales of broadband"
AND
Page 4, delete line 13 and substitute the following:
"(b) As used in this section 'broadband technology' has the same"
AND
Page 4, delete line 16 and substitute the following:
"SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act shall become effective on the first
day of"
