## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 981.

Amend Senate Bill No. 981 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 10, delete "HEALTH" and substitute "HUMAN SERVICES"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute: "AN ACT CONCERNING THE DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES; TO PROTECT YOUNG CHILDREN AND CONCERNING MATURE VIDEO AND COMPUTER SOFTWARE GAMES."

AND

Delete lines 25 through 33 and substitute the following:

"20-27-1701. Human Services Department -- Mature video games or computer games.

- (a) A person who sells or rents video games or computer software games that are rated by the Entertainment Software Rating Board as "M" for mature or "AO" for adults only shall display the video games or computer games:
  - (1) At a height of at least five feet (5') above the floor; or
- (2) In an area that is enclosed on three (3) sides and posted with a sign stating: "WARNING. Materials in this section are not suitable for children."
- (b)(l) This section shall be enforced by the county director of Department of Human Services in each county or by the county director's designee.
- (2)(A) The department shall impose a civil fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) for each distinct, noncontinuous violation of subsection (a) of this section.
- (B) All civil fines shall be deposited in the State Treasury in the County Operations Fund Account of the Department of Human
