Immediately following Section 2, add an additional section to read as follows: "SECTION 3: Arkansas Code 18-44-115(e)(2)(B), concerning notice to owners of commercial real estate being improved, is amended to read as follows: This The notice shall be sent to the owner and to the contractor by registered mail, return receipt requested and may be served by any officer authorized by law to service process in civil actions or by any form of mail addressed to the person to be served, with a return receipt requested, before seventy-five (75) days have elapsed from the time that the labor was supplied or the material furnished."
