### Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1068.

Amend House Bill No. 1068 as originally introduced:

Page 3, line 7, delete "(c)" and substitute "~~(c)~~(b)"

AND

Page 3, line 17, delete "(a)" and substitute "(a)(1)"

AND

Page 3, line 19, delete "or remove"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 22 and 23, and substitute the following:

"(2) A violation of subdivision (a)(1) of this section is a Class D felony for the first offense and a Class C felony for a subsequent offense.

(b)(1) It is unlawful for any person, natural or corporate, to knowingly remove an artifact from the private land of the owner without first obtaining the owner's permission.

(2) A violation of subdivision (b)(1) of this section is a Class C misdemeanor for the first offense and a Class B misdemeanor for a subsequent offense."
