Subtitle of House Bill No. 1206

"TO ALLOW A PERMIT FOR THE MOVEMENT OF EARTHMOVING EQUIPMENT THAT
IS A TRACTOR WITH A DIRT PAN IN TOW UPON THE STATE HIGHWAYS IF THE
OWNER IS PRIMARILY ENGAGED IN FARMING OR EARTHMOVING OPERATIONS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1206.

Amend House Bill No. 1206 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 28 through 35 and substitute the following:

"(C) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision
(a)(2)(A) of this section, permits may be issued for the movement of
earthmoving equipment that is a tractor with dirt pan in tow used primarily
for farming operations to travel upon the state highways in excess of a
fifty-mile radius of the point of origin or for the movement of earthmoving
equipment that is a tractor with dirt pan in tow used primarily for
commercial earthmoving operations for travel upon state highways of any
distance subject to the following requirements:

(i) The permit shall be issued only to owners of the
vehicles who are primarily engaged in farming or commercial earthmoving
operations;"
