Subtitle of House Bill No. 1311

"TO AMEND 5-14-110 TO MAKE THE OFFENSE OF SEXUAL INDECENCY WITH A CHILD APPLICABLE TO PERSONS LESS THAN EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1311.

Amend House Bill No. 1311 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 5 in its entirety and substitute the following:

"(3) With the purpose to arouse or gratify a sexual desire of himself or herself or a sexual desire of any other person, the person purposely exposes his or her sex organs to another person who is less than eighteen (18) years of age, and the actor is:

(A) Employed with the Department of Correction, Department of Community Correction, any city or county jail, or any juvenile detention facility, and the minor is in custody at a facility operated by the agency or contractor employing the actor; or

(B) A professional under § 12-12-507(b) and is in a position of trust or authority over the minor; or

(C) The minor's guardian, an employee in the minor's school or school district, a temporary caretaker, or a person in a position of trust or authority over the minor; or

(4) Being eighteen (18) years of age or older, the person causes"
