Subtitle of House Bill No. 1318

"AN ACT TO CREATE THE SURPLUS POULTRY LITTER REMOVAL INCENTIVES ACT
AND TO PROVIDE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES FOR POULTRY LITTER
REMOVAL."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1318.

Amend House Bill No. 1318 as originally introduced:

Add Representative George as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Add Senator Lavery as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 4, line 3 add the following:

"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that lawsuits concerning poultry litter have created a crisis in poultry litter distribution in Arkansas; that tax incentives for transportation of poultry litter will provide immediate relief to both Arkansas poultry producers and Arkansas poultry litter applicators; and that this act is immediately necessary because many poultry litter applications are made once a year and any delay in transportation will further exacerbate the already serious crisis. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
