Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1387.

Amend House Bill No. 1387 as engrossed, H2/8/07 (version: 02-08-2007 09:36):

Page 2, delete lines 19 and 20, and substitute the following:

"(b) Except as provided under subsection (c) of this section, a clause in a public construction agreement or public construction contract entered into after the effective date of this section is unenforceable as"

AND

Page 3, line 6, add the following:

"(e) A clause described under subsections (b) and (c) of this section is severable from the public construction agreement or public construction contract and shall not cause the entire public construction agreement or public construction contract to become unenforceable."

AND

Page 3, delete line 36, and substitute the following:

"(b) Except as provided under subsection (c) of this section, a clause in a"

AND

Page 4, delete line 1, and substitute the following:

"construction agreement or construction contract entered into after the effective date of this section is unenforceable as against"

AND



Page 4, line 22, add the following:

"(e) A clause described under subsections (b) and (c) of this section is severable from the construction agreement or construction contract and shall not cause the entire construction agreement or construction contract to become unenforceable."
