# Subtitle of House Bill No. 1466 <br> "TO CLARIFY THE LAW REGARDING THE ENTITLEMENT TO A SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE CHILDREN AND SPOUSE OF CERTAIN PUBLIC SERVICE EMPLOYEES IF THE PUBLIC SERVICE RESULTS IN DEATH OR PERMANENT AND TOTAL DISABILITY." 

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1466.

Amend House Bill No. 1466 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 6 and substitute:
"technical institute.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that confusion exists regarding the law and that people are being denied scholarships under Arkansas Code § 6-82503 because the public service employee was returning from a location where a hazardous situation existed; that the risks that public service employees take in the scope of going to and returning from hazardous situations are equally high; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that public service employees who risk their lives and health are treated equally. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or
(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
