Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1466.

Amend House Bill No. 1466 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 6 and substitute:

"technical institute.

SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that confusion exists regarding the</u> <u>law and that people are being denied scholarships under Arkansas Code § 6-82-503 because the public service employee was returning from a location where a <u>hazardous situation existed; that the risks that public service employees</u> <u>take in the scope of going to and returning from hazardous situations are</u> <u>equally high; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that</u> <u>public service employees who risk their lives and health are treated equally.</u> <u>Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for</u> <u>the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become</u> <u>effective on:</u></u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
