Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1474.

Amend House Bill No. 1474 as engrossed, H2/21/07 (version: 02-21-2007 08:53):

Page 2, delete line 2 and substitute the following: "the buyer is a <u>county coroner, a certified</u> law enforcement officer<u>, or a</u> <u>constable with one hundred twenty (120) hours of training</u>"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 22 through 25 and substitute the following: "(C) to possess To possess a blue light that that is not sealed in the manufacturer's original package in or on any vehicle in this state other than: (i) In a vehicle owned or leased and operated and maintained by a federal, state, county, or city law enforcement agency; or, a blue light that is not sealed in the manufacturer's package. (ii)(a) By a constable in his or her properly marked vehicle. (b) The constable shall sell, donate, or destroy the blue light upon leaving office."
