Subtitle of House Bill No. 1528

"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION -
DISBURSING OFFICER - COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS OF ARKANSAS, INC.
GRANTS APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2007- 2009 BIENNIUM."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1528.

Amend House Bill No. 1528 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 10 through 13 in their entirety and substitute the following:

"OF RURAL SERVICES FOR COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER GRANTS; AND FOR"

And

Page 1, delete lines 18 through 22 in their entirety and substitute "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL SERVICES – COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER GRANTS GENERAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION."

And

Page 1, delete lines 27 through 35 in their entirety and substitute the following:

" SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION – COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) For Community Health Centers of Arkansas, Inc. Grants to provide primary medical, dental, mental health, pharmacy and preventive services targeted to the uninsured and underinsured Arkansans in the medically underserved areas in rural Arkansas, the sum of\$30,000,000."

And

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 in their entirety

And



Add a new section immediately following SECTION 1 to read as follows:

“ SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANTS. The grants authorized in Section 1 of this act shall not be restricted by local population limitations, dollar amount limitations, or dollar matching requirements that may be applicable to other grant programs currently administered by the Department of Rural Services. The Department of Rural Services may adopt rules and regulations to carry out the intent of the General Assembly regarding the grant appropriations authorized in Section 1 of this Act.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.”

And

Appropriately renumber subsequent sections of the bill.
