Subtitle of House Bill No. 1617

"TO LIMIT THE USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN BY DEFINING "PUBLIC USE" AND TO
ABOLISH A LOCAL GOVERNMENT'S RIGHT OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO CONDEMN
PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT."

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1617.

Amend House Bill No. 1617 as engrossed, H3/1/07 (version: 03-01-2007 09:14):

Page 1, delete the TITLE in its entirety and substitute the following:
"AN ACT TO ABOLISH A LOCAL GOVERNMENT'S RIGHT OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO CONDEMN
PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, delete the SUBTITLE in its entirety and substitute the following:
"TO ABOLISH A LOCAL GOVERNMENT'S RIGHT OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO CONDEMN PRIVATE
PROPERTY FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT."

AND

Page 1, strike all of the language after the enacting clause and substitute
the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-168-304(7), concerning a local
government's right of eminent domain to condemn private property for economic
redevelopment, is repealed.

~~(7)(A) Exercise the right of eminent domain to condemn property
for the purposes of implementing the project plan.~~

~~(B) The rules and procedures set forth in §§ 18-15-301 -
18-15-307 shall govern all condemnation proceedings authorized in this
subchapter;~~

SECTION 2. NOT TO BE CODIFIED. Nothing in this act shall expand or
limit a municipal corporation's power of eminent domain under §§ 18-15-301 -
18-15-309."
