"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT - ARKANSAS
MINORITY BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT ROUNDTABLE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT
APPROPRIATION."

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 2085.

Amend House Bill No. 2085 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 11, delete "ROUNDTABLE"

AND

Page 1, line 18, delete "ROUNDTABLE"

AND

Page 1, line 24, delete "ROUNDTABLE"

AND

Page 1, line 28, delete "operational" and substitute "a grant for"

AND

Page 1, line 28, delete "the"

AND

Page 1, line 29, delete "Roundtable for aid to the Arkansas Minority Business
Development"

AND

Insert additional SECTIONS immediately following SECTION 1 to read as
follows"

"SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANTS.
The grants authorized in Section 1 of this act shall not be restricted by



local population limitations, dollar amount limitations, or dollar matching requirements that may be applicable to other grant programs currently administered by the Department of Economic Development. The Department of Economic Development may adopt rules and regulations to carry out the intent of the General Assembly regarding the grant appropriations authorized in Section 1 of this Act.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.

SECTION 3. As referenced in SECTION 3 of the Act introduced as Senate Bill 833 of 2007, the authorized funding for the project for operational support of the Arkansas Minority Business Development Roundtable for aid to the Arkansas Minority Business Development shall instead be deemed to be for a grant for support of Arkansas Minority Business Development.

SECTION 4. As referenced in SECTION 3 of the Act introduced as House Bill 2501 of 2007, the authorized funding for the project for operational support of the Arkansas Minority Business Development Roundtable for aid to the Arkansas Minority Business Development shall instead be deemed to be for a grant for support of Arkansas Minority Business Development."

AND

Appropriately renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill.
