Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2336.
Amend House Bill No. 2336 as originally introduced:
Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:
"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 14, Subchapter 1 is amended
to add an additional section to read as follows: 5-14-130. Registered offender prohibited from entering upon school
campus — Exception.
(a) As used in this section:
(1) "Campus" means the real property, a building, or any other
improvement in this state owned, leased, rented, or controlled by a public
school district; and
(2) "Public school district" means any public school district in
this state serving students in a kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12)
program or a grade one through grade twelve (1-12) program. (b) It is unlawful for a sex offender who is required to register
under the Sex Offender Registration Act of 1997, § 12-12-901 et seq., and who
has been assessed as a Level 2, Level 3, or Level 4 offender to knowingly
enter upon the campus of a public school district without prior written
permission issued by the public school district.
(c) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules as necessary
to establish the procedure and method of issuance of the written permission
described in subsection (b) of this section.
(d) Upon conviction, any sex offender who violates this section is
guilty of a Class D felony."
