Subtitle of House Bill No. 2597 "TO CREATE A COUNTY ASSESSOR CONTINUING EDUCATION BOARD."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2597.

Amend House Bill No. 2597 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 9, delete "ASSESSOR" and substitute "ASSESSORS"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following: "TO CREATE A COUNTY ASSESSORS CONTINUING EDUCATION BOARD."

AND

Delete Section 1 of the bill and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 15, Subchapter 2 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

14-15-206. County Assessors Continuing Education Board


(a) There is created the County Assessors Continuing Education Board which shall be composed of the following six (6) members:

(1)(A) Five (5) members appointed by the Governor from a list of at least ten (10) persons submitted by the Arkansas Assessors Association.

(B)(i) Two (2) of the members shall be contractors or appraisers who have at a minimum a Level 4 certification.

(ii) Three (3) of the members shall be assessors or deputy assessors who have at a minimum a Level 4 certification; and

- (2) The Director of the Assessment Coordination Department or a person designated by the director.
- (b) The members of the board shall attend board meetings at their own expense.
- (c) It shall be the responsibility of the County Assessors Continuing Education Board to:
- (1) Maintain communication with the county assessors and other assessment professionals in Arkansas to determine their educational needs;
- (2) Convey educational needs and concerns of the county assessors and other assessment professionals in Arkansas and to work in conjunction with any education committee or workgroup:
 - (A) Formed by the Assessment Coordination Department's



rule; and

- (B) Composed of representatives from all sectors of the assessing profession in Arkansas;
- (3) Plan educational seminars to provide county assessors and other assessment professionals the opportunity to achieve professional designations and earn continuing education credits to maintain those designations;
- (4) Plan educational seminars to provide county assessors and other assessment professionals the opportunity to improve their ability to carry out their official responsibilities in an efficient and effective manner; and
- (5) Approve the expenditures of the County Assessors' Continuing Education Trust Fund disbursed by the Assessment Coordination Department."
