Subtitle of House Bill No. 2671

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE EQUITY AND SEVERANCE CONSIDERATION FOR CHIEFS OF
POLICE."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2671.

Amend House Bill No. 2671 as originally introduced:

Delete everything following the enacting clause and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 52, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

14-52-113. Severance consideration for certain chiefs of police.

(a) A person employed as a chief of police of a city of the first class or a city of the second class who is not covered by civil service or a written employment contract shall be paid a severance consideration when:

(1) The person's employment as chief of police is involuntarily terminated;

(2) The person resigns under threat of termination; or

(3) The person resigns at the request of the appointing authority.

(b)(1) Severance consideration under this section shall be equal to the person's monthly salary multiplied by the number of years of service as chief of police of the municipality.

(2) Severance consideration under this section shall not exceed fifty percent (50%) of the person's annual salary at the time of termination or resignation of employment."
