Amend House Bill No. 2779 as engrossed, H3/26/07 (version: 03-26-2007 09:35):
Delete everything following the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act of 2007."

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 60, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

5-60-126. Concealing persons illegally in the United States.

- (a) It is unlawful for a person to knowingly perform an overt act designed to conceal, harbor, or shelter from detection another person in any place, including without limitation any building or means of transportation, knowing that the other person has come to, entered, or remained in the United States in violation of law.
- (b) Upon conviction, any person violating subsection (a) of this section is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor."
