Subtitle of House Joint Resolution No. 1004

"PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PROVIDE THAT
APPROPRIATION BILLS ARE VALID FOR ONE FISCAL YEAR; TO REQUIRE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY TO MEET IN FISCAL SESSION DURING EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS; AND
TO SET LENGTH OF SESSIONS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Joint Resolution No. 1004.

Amend House Joint Resolution No. 1004 as originally introduced:

Add the following Representatives as cosponsors of the bill:

"Adcock, R. Green, Greenberg, Hardwick, Jeffrey, Ragland, Reynolds,
Rosenbaum, Saunders, Sumpter"

AND

Page 2, delete line 18 and substitute the following:

"General Assembly approve consideration of the bill.

(d) The General Assembly, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members
elected to each house of the General Assembly, may alter the dates of the
regular session and fiscal session so that regular sessions occur in even-
numbered years and the fiscal sessions occur in odd-numbered years."

AND

Page 4, delete lines 17 and 18 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 8. Nothing in this amendment shall be construed to alter the
Governor's authority to call a special session of the General Assembly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment shall become effective on
January 1, 2009."
