## Amendment No. 1 to House Joint Resolution No. 1020.

Amend House Joint Resolution No. 1020 as originally introduced:


Page 1, in the header above line 1 insert the following language: "Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the Arkansas Constitution."

AND

- Page 2, delete lines 11 through 19 and substitute the following: "(a) The clerks of the circuit courts shall be elected by the qualified electors of the several counties for the term of two four (4) years, and shall be ex-officio clerks of the county and probate courts, exofficio probate clerks of the circuit courts, and recorder; provided, that in.
- (b) However, any county having a population exceeding fifteen thousand inhabitants, as shown by the last Federal census, there shall be elected may elect a county clerk, in like manner as the clerk of the circuit court, for the term of four (4) years. , and in In such a case, the county clerk shall be ex-officio probate clerk of the probate circuit court of such the county until otherwise provided by the General Assembly."

AND

- Page 2, delete lines 24 through 29 and substitute the following: "The Judge of the County Court shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county for the term of two four (4) years. He or she shall be:
  - (1) at At least twenty-five (25) years of age;
  - (2) a A citizen of the United States;
- (3) a man A person of upright character, and of good business education, and;



- $\underline{(4)}$  a  $\underline{A}$  resident of the State for two  $\underline{(2)}$  years before his or her election; and
- (5) a  $\underline{A}$  resident of the county at the time of his <u>or her</u> election, and during his <u>or her</u> continuance in office."

Page 2, line 33, delete "Justices" and substitute "\ 38. Justices"

AND

Page 2, line 36, delete "commission." And substitute "commission."

AND

Page 3, line 4, delete "Qualifications" and substitute "\{\frac{41.}{2}}\)

AND

- Page 3, delete lines 10 through 17 and substitute the following:
  - "§ 46. County executive officers Compensation of county assessor.
  - (a) The qualified electors of each county shall elect:
- (1) one One (1) Sheriff, who shall be ex-officio collector of taxes, unless otherwise provided by law;
  - (2) one <u>One (1)</u> Assessor;
  - (3) one One (1) Coroner;
- (4) one One (1) Treasurer, who shall be ex-officio treasurer of the common school fund of the county; and
  - (5) one One (1) County Surveyor;.
- (b) A person elected under subsection (a) of this section shall serve for the term of two four (4) years, with such duties as are now or may be prescribed by law: Provided, that. However, no per centum shall ever be paid to assessors upon the valuation or assessment of property by them."

- Page 3, delete lines 22 through 26 and substitute the following:
- " $\underline{(a)}$  The provisions for the election of a County Clerk upon a population basis are  $\frac{\text{hereby}}{\text{hereby}}$  abolished.
- (b) and there may be elected a  $\underline{A}$  County Clerk may be elected in like manner as a Circuit Clerk, for the term of four (4) years. and in  $\underline{In}$  such cases, the County Clerk may  $\underline{shall}$  be ex officio  $\underline{Probate}$  Clerk of the  $\underline{Probate}$  Circuit Court of  $\underline{such}$  the county until otherwise provided by the General Assembly."
