Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 120

"AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR REAL ESTATE LICENSE APPLICANTS."

Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 120.

Amend Senate Bill No. 120 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete line 31 and substitute the following: "check.

SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that current Arkansas law prevents</u> <u>an applicant from sitting for the real estate examination until the receipt</u> <u>of a state and federal background check by the Arkansas Real Estate</u> <u>Commission; that these background checks take a great deal of time to</u> <u>complete; and that requiring an applicant to delay taking the examination</u> <u>until the background checks are received unfairly punishes the applicant and</u> <u>negatively affects the real estate profession. Therefore, an emergency is</u> <u>declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the</u> <u>public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
