Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 196.

Amend Senate Bill No. 196 as originally introduced:

Page 3, delete lines 18 through 27 and substitute:

"(5) A driver with an intermediate driver's license shall not
operate a motor vehicle on public streets or highways between the hours of
11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. unless the driver is:

(A) Accompanied by a licensed driver who is twenty-one
(21) years of age or older;

(B) Driving to or from a school activity or a job; or

(C) Driving for an emergency."
