MATERIALS AND TO MINIMIZE THE COST OF TEXTBOOKS AND COURSE
MATERIALS AT STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 22.

Amend Senate Bill No. 22 as engrossed, S2/12/07 (version: 02-12-2007 09:11):

Page 1, line 33, delete "materials" and substitute "materials for
undergraduate courses"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 16 and substitute the following:
"(a) of this section shall require that before the selection of a textbook or
course material is finalized, the appropriate faculty member shall:
(1) Affirmatively confirm his or her intent to use all items
selected, including all items sold as part of a bundled package;
(2) Confirm that some components of a bundled package may not be
reusable by another student;
(3) Affirmatively acknowledge the quoted on-campus retail price
for each textbook or course material he or she selects; and
(4) Confirm that the publisher of a textbook or course material
has acknowledged that all components of a bundled package may be purchased
and sold separately by a local textbook retailer."

Page 2, line 17, delete "(c)(1)" and substitute "(c)"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 22 through 34
