Amend Senate Bill No. 261 as engrossed, S3/5/07 (version: 03-05-2007 14:35):

Delete SECTION 24 in its entirety and substitute the following:

"SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CHARTER
SCHOOL FUNDING RESTRICTIONS. Regardless of any provision of any law to the
contrary, the Department of Education shall fund from state monies only those
charter schools which provide education services in a traditional public
school setting and, if the internet or long-distance learning technology is
used, the internet or long-distance learning technology is used as a
supplement to the school's traditional classroom setting.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2005}{1}$  2007 through June 30,  $\frac{2007}{1}$  2009."
