Amendment No. 4 to Senate Bill No. 304.

Amend Senate Bill No. 304 as engrossed, S2/20/07 (version: 02-20-2007 14:00):

Page 3, delete line 22 and substitute the following:

"(d)(1) This section does not apply to small farm wineries.

(2) As used in this subsection, "small farm winery" means a wine-making establishment that does not sell more than two hundred fifty thousand (250,000) gallons of wine, the alcohol content of which does not exceed twenty-one percent (21%), annually as reported on the federal tax report form TTB 5120-17, as it existed on January 1,2007."
