Page 2, delete lines 17 through 19 and substitute the following: "(2)(A) The person knowingly makes more than one (1) telephone communication to a third party for the purpose of acquiring consumer location information, unless the third party consents to future calls or is obligated to pay the debt. (B) Subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section does not apply to a telephone call by a public utility, a commercial mobile radio service provider, or an agent or contractor of the public utility or the commercial mobile radio service provider." Page 2, delete line 36 and substitute the following: "judicial officer shall enter such orders as are consistent with § 5-2-305. (f) A federally insured depository institution is in compliance with this section if the institution is in compliance with all debt collection regulations issued by the institution's primary state or federal regulator."
