person is sentenced under subsection (a) of this section if the underlying
felony was any of the following: (a) Manufacture of methamphetamine, § 5-64-
401(a)(1); or
(b) Possession of drug paraphernalia with the
intent to manufacture methamphetamine, § 5-64-403(c)(5).
(ii) The person is eligible for parole or community correction transfer if the person serves at least fifty percent (50%) of the
term of imprisonment to which the person is sentenced under subsection (a) of
this section for the offenses listed in subdivision (e)(1)(B)(i) of this
section with credit for the award of meritorious good time under § 12-29-202
unless the person is sentenced to a term of life imprisonment; or"
