Amend Senate Bill No. 868 as originally introduced:
Add Representative Blount as a cosponsor of the bill
AND
Page 2, delete lines 5 through 20 and substitute the following:
(c) Human services workers shall have a bachelor's degree or a
master's degree in social work or related field and shall provide the
following services according to skills and training:
<ul><li>(1) Crisis intervention;</li><li>(2) School conferences and in-service training;</li></ul>
(3) Home visits;
(4) Transportation for family and student group counseling;
(5) Parent training and activities;
(6) Supportive service referrals;
(7) Individualized coping and conflict management skills; and
(8) Assessment of family and student needs.
(d)(1) Funding for human services workers shall be targeted to schools
with ninety percent (90%) or more children eligible for the Free and Reduced
Lunch program under the National School Lunch Act.  (2) The Department of Education and the division shall develop
criteria to prioritize eligibility for the Human Services Worker in the
Schools Program.
