Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 974

"AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ARKANSAS TASK FORCE ON RACIAL PROFILING."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 974.

Amend Senate Bill No. 974 as originally introduced:

Delete Section 1 of the bill and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-8-104(k) is amended to read as follows: (k) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police may <u>shall</u> implement <u>or assist other entities to develop and implement</u> a public service campaign concerning racial profiling and may utilize brochures, flyers, or public service announcements.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1403(b), concerning law enforcement agency policies on racial profiling, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) Each law enforcement agency shall include a copy of the law enforcement agency's policy in the annual report that the law enforcement agency submits to the Division of Legislative Audit.

(2) The Division of Legislative Audit shall submit to the Attorney General the names of any law enforcement agency that fails to comply with subdivision (b)(1) of this section, and the Attorney General shall take such action as may be necessary to enforce this section.

(3) The Division of Legislative Audit shall forward to the Attorney General a copy of each policy received by the division. The Attorney General shall review each policy to ensure that the policy meets the standards required by law.

(c)(1) Each law enforcement agency shall promote public awareness of the law enforcement agency's efforts to comply with the mandates of this section.

(2) In addition, each law enforcement agency shall make available for public inspection a copy of the law enforcement agency's policy written in both English and Spanish."
