Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 992.

Amend Senate Bill No. 992 as originally introduced:

(b)(1)(A)(i) The county board of election commissioners may decide to hold early voting at additional polling sites outside the offices of the county clerk and to include the additional voting locations for a maximum of fifteen (15) days on any of the days and times provided for in subsection (a) of this section, if it so chooses.

(ii) If a county contains an incorporated town with a population of more than three thousand (3,000) and the incorporated town is more than twelve (12) miles from the office of the county clerk by way of state or federal highway, the county board of election commissioners shall place an early voting polling site in the incorporated town."
