Subtitle of Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 23

"ENCOURAGING THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION TO USE REVENUES
GENERATED BY THE FAYETTEVILLE SHALE PLAY TO INCREASE HUNTING
ACCESSIBILITY FOR HANDICAPPED ARKANSANS AND TEACH SAFE HUNTING
PRACTICES TO CHILDREN."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 23.

Amend Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 23 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 13 and substitute the following:
"ENCOURAGING THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION TO ADOPT CERTAIN USES OF
REVENUE GENERATED BY THE FAYETTEVILLE SHALE PLAY."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 16 through 21 and substitute the following:
"ENCOURAGING THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION TO ADOPT CERTAIN USES OF
REVENUE GENERATED BY THE FAYETTEVILLE SHALE PLAY."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 24 through 31 and substitute the following:
"WHEREAS, the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission will benefit
financially from oil, gas, and other minerals under lands owned by the
commission which are part of the Fayetteville shale play; and

WHEREAS, these funds will enable the commission to take new approaches
towards accomplishing the purposes of the commission,

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE HOUSE
OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission is encouraged to use
revenues generated by the Fayetteville shale play to increase hunting
accessibility for handicapped Arkansans, to teach safe hunting practices to
children, and to assist local governments with infrastructure growth,
especially those local governments in areas with immediate needs resulting



from high volumes of heavy traffic and population increases due to the Fayetteville shale play.”
