### Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1027.

Amend House Bill No. 1027 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 25-28, delete "(2) A violation of this section is a Class D felony if:

(A) A victim is under seventeen (17) years of age; ~~and or~~

(B) The person who commits the offense ~~holds a position of trust or authority over the victim~~ is eighteen (18) years of age or older" and substitute "(c) (1) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, a violation of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

~~(2) A violation of this section is a Class D felony if:~~

~~(A) A victim is under seventeen (17) years of age; and~~

~~(B) The person who commits the offense holds a position of trust or authority over the victim.~~

(c)(1) A violation of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

(2) However, a violation of this section is a Class D felony if the person committing the act is eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time he or she commits the offense."
