Amend House Bill No. 1566 as originally introduced: Page 1, delete lines 27 through 30 and substitute: "(B) However, as used in § 5-68-502, "material" does not include a matter displayed, transmitted, retrieved, or stored on the Internet or other network for the electronic dissemination of information;" Page 1, delete lines 35 and 36 and substitute: "(15) "Transmits" means to send material by an electronic device or equipment, including without limitation material displayed, retrieved, or stored on a computer, analog cellular telephone, digital wireless telephone, the Internet, or other network for electronic dissemination." Page 2, delete line 1 Page 3, delete lines 8 through 13 and substitute:

(1) A minor; or

(2) An individual the person believes is a minor.

- (b) It is an affirmative defense to a prosecution under this section that the actor was not more than three (3) years older than the victim.
