Subtitle of House Bill No. 1633

"AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF FOSTER PARENTS AND PREADOPTIVE PARENTS REGARDING CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1633.

Amend House Bill No. 1633 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 32 and 33 and substitute the following:

"is of the parent's blood, an adopted child, or a stepchild, ~~or~~ a foster child not in custody of the Department of Human Services, or a preadoptive child not in custody of the Department of Human Services."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 34 through 36

AND

Page 3, delete lines 1 through 4 and substitute the following:

"(iii) Ongoing medical treatment;
(iv) Nonsurgical procedures by a primary care
provider; and
(v) Nonsurgical procedures by a specialty care
provider.

(B) The Department of Human Services shall be given timely notice of all admissions and discharges consented to by a foster parent or preadoptive parent for a child in custody of the Department of Human Services.

(C) The consent of a representative of the Department of Human Services is required for:

(i) Nonemergency surgical procedures;
(ii) Nonemergency invasive procedures;
(iii) "End of life" non-emergency procedures such as do-not-resuscitate orders, withdrawal of life support, and organ donation;

(iv) Nonemergency medical procedures relating to a
