Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2266.

Amend House Bill No. 2266 as originally introduced:

Delete everything following the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-10-103(c)(2)(D), concerning filing by petition as a candidate for district judge is amended to read as follows: (D) Candidates by petition for district judge shall file petitions signed by at least thirty (30) qualified electors who reside within the district for which the candidate seeks office three percent (3%) of the qualified electors residing within the district for which the candidate seeks office, but in no event shall more than two thousand (2,000) signatures be required."
