## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 257.

Amend Senate Bill No. 257 as originally introduced:

Insert an additional SECTION immediately following SECTION 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>COURT</u> <u>REPORTERS. Official court reporters shall prepare transcripts, which are to</u> <u>be included within a record on appeal, pursuant to the time requirements that</u> <u>are outlined in the Arkansas Supreme Court Rules. In the event an official</u> <u>court reporter fails to complete a transcript within the prescribed time, he</u> <u>or she shall immediately inform the judge, for whom he or she is employed,</u> <u>and the Arkansas Board of Certified Court Reporter Examiners. Failure of a</u> <u>court reporter to report to his or her judge and to the Arkansas Board of</u> <u>Certified Court Reporter Examiners shall result in the immediate suspension</u> <u>of the court reporter's license, pending a hearing before the Arkansas Board</u> <u>of Certified Court Reporter Examiners."</u>

Appropriately renumber the remaining SECTION numbers of the bill.
