Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 780

"TO PROVIDE FORFEITURE OF OR DISQUALIFICATION FROM PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT
ON CONVICTION OF AN OFFENSE RELATED TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 780.

Amend Senate Bill No. 780 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 30, delete "(a)(1)" and substitute "(a)"

AND

Page 1, delete lines 32 through 36

AND

Page 2, line 1, delete "official" and substitute "servant"

AND

Page 2, delete line 13 and substitute the following:
"municipality, county, school district, institution of higher education,
improvement district, or any political"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 23 through 27 and substitute the following:
"25-16-1103. Forfeiture of office.
(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a public
servant holding any office, position, or employment in a governmental body
shall forfeit the office, position, or employment if he or she pleads guilty
or nolo contendere to or is found guilty of a felony offense relating to the
public servant's office, position, or employment.
(b) This section shall not apply to a member of the General Assembly
subject to removal from office under Article 5 of the Arkansas Constitution."

AND

Page 3, delete line 4 and substitute the following:
"(2) If the issue of forfeiture is raised, following sentencing a



circuit court shall"

AND

Page 3, delete line 24 and substitute the following:

"servant for an offense other than a felony.

25-16-1107. Effect of expungement.

An expunged record shall not serve as the basis for forfeiture of office or disqualification from office under this subchapter."
