## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 85.

Amend Senate Bill No. 85 as originally introduced:

Immediately following SECTION 1 add an additional section to read as follows:
 "SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that recent disasters have created
a serious shortage of human blood; that to prevent future shortages, the pool
of donors must be increased; and that this act is immediately necessary
because a broad, new pool of blood donors will become available to help
alleviate the immediate shortage and to prevent future shortages of human
blood. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and
safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
