Arkansas Code § 17-106-108(b), concerning acceptable aminations, is amended to read as follows: (b) The State Board of Health shall identify acceptable examinations is those administered by the American Registry of Radiologic chnologists, the American Chiropractic Registry of Radiologic Technologists in didactic training of a forty-eight-hour program recommended by the erican Chiropractic Registry of Radiologic Technologists and administered a Diplomate of the American Chiropractic Board of Radiology, or the clear Medicine Technology Certification Board.
SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-106-111(a), concerning exemptions from a chapter, is amended to read as follows: (a)(1) Dentists, dental hygienists, registered dental assistants with expanded duty of radiography, radiation health physicists, radiation dical physicists, chiropractic externs, bone densitometrists, and certified dical dosimetrists are excluded from this chapter. (2) Any exemptions from the provisions of this chapter are clusive to those enumerated in this subsection."
