## Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 998.

Amend Senate Bill No. 998 as engrossed, S3/23/09 (version: 03-23-2009 09:28):

Page 1, delete lines 28 through 31 and substitute the following language: "(2) Review any policies or changes to policies proposed by the board of directors; and

(3) Propose additional policies or amendments to existing personnel policies to the board of directors."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 2 through 6 and substitute the following language: "(2) New personnel policies or amendments to existing personnel policies proposed by the board of directors may not be voted on by the board of directors as a school district policy unless the final form of the policy to be voted on has been submitted as a proposed policy to the committee for consideration at least ten (10) working days prior to presentation to before the vote of the board of directors."



Page 2, delete lines 9 through 11 and substitute the following language: "(B) The recommendations shall may then become proposals if adopted by at the discretion of either the board of directors or the committee."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 13 and 14 and substitute the following language: "chair shall be placed on the board of directors' agenda and shall have the opportunity to orally present to the board of directors the committee's comments, positions, or proposals on the final form of any proposed"

Page 2, delete lines 18 through 20 and substitute the following language:  "(e) After the oral presentation to the board of directors, final action shall may be taken immediately, but final action shall be taken no later than the next regular board of directors meeting."

Page 2, line 21 delete ", subject to"

Page 2, line 22 delete "the committee review and presentation requirements under this section,"
