Subtitle of House Bill No. 1401

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2011-
2012 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1401

Amend House Bill No. 1401 as originally introduced:

Page 10, add a new section immediately following SECTION 12 to read as follows:

" SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this section, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of one million three hundred eighty six thousand dollars (\$1,386,000) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Department of Correction Inmate Care and Custody Fund Account to provide funds for the payment of straight time and overtime liability accrued."

AND

Appropriately renumber the subsequent sections.

AND

Delete the EMERGENCY CLAUSE in its entirety and substitute the following:

" SECTION 39. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an extension of the Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011, with the exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of



essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011; with the exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.”
