"SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the
State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System currently requires that
retirement contributions be based on a member's base salary plus any multipliers; that retirement
contributions and benefits should be determined based on a member's base salary and not any
multipliers or special salary allowances; and that this act is immediately necessary to clarify the meaning
of the term "compensation" for purposes of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System.

Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

- (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or
- (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
