Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 348

Amend Senate Bill No. 348 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 11 and substitute "INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:


"TO PROVIDE THAT THE ARKANSAS AGRICULTURAL MARKETING GRANTS FUND SHALL ALSO BE USED TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO VITICULTURE AND ENOLOGY PROGRAMS AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY."

AND

Page 3, line 21, add the following:

"SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the wine industry is a vital component of Arkansas's economy; that research in the area of viticulture and enology is important to the continued success of the wine industry in Arkansas; and that this act is immediately necessary to fund viticulture and enology programs that will contribute to a more robust industry and economy. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

- (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or
