TO ESTABLISH THE QUALIFICATIONS OF PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 878

Amend Senate Bill No. 878 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-109 is amended to read as follows: 6-13-109. School superintendent.

(a) The public school districts in the state shall each <u>Each public</u> <u>school district in the state shall</u> employ a superintendent of schools, whose qualifications and duties shall be prescribed by the General Assembly and the State Board of Education.

(b) <u>The qualifications established by the state board shall include</u> without limitation the individual's:

(1) Residency;

(2) Education;

(3) Leadership or educator experience; and

(4) Licensure.

(c)(1) "Superintendent of schools" is defined The duties of a superintendent shall include without limitation acting as the executive officer of a school district board of directors directing the affairs of the school district.

(2) A superintendent shall not teach and teaching not more than one-half $\binom{1}{2}$ of the time in the school day."
