AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CAREER EDUCATION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1063

Amend House Bill No. 1063 as engrossed, H2/14/12 (version: 02/14/2012 09:30:15 AM)

Insert a new Section immediately following Section 24 to read as follows:

"SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>SECONDARY</u> <u>TECHNICAL CENTER AID PROVISIONS.</u>

(a)(1) Secondary technical center aid shall be calculated and distributed by the Department of Career Education based upon each secondary technical center's eligible student full-time equivalent count.

(2) Secondary technical center aid shall not be based upon the percentage of total enrollment from any one sending school.

(b) This section expires on June 30, 2013.

And

Delete Section 27, the EMERGENCY CLAUSE, in its entirety and substitute the following:

" SECTION 28. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the exception that SECTION 25 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs, with the exception that SECTION 25 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012; with the exception that SECTION 25 in



this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval."

And

Appropriately renumber the Sections of the bill.
