AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1114

Amend House Bill No. 1114 as engrossed, H2/27/12 (version: 02/27/2012 02:36:27 PM)

Delete SECTION 79 in its entirety and substitute the following:

- "SECTION 79. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUNDING GRANTS TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS</u>. After funds collected pursuant to §26-57-614 are distributed in accordance with §14-284-403, any remaining balance of authorized funding for grants to fire departments for Crittenden County during the 2010-2011 fiscal year in the amount of one hundred fifty-three thousand nine hundred and forty-eight dollars (\$153,948) or above, shall be distributed as follows:
- (a) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Anthonyville Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (b) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Crawfordsville Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (c) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Earle Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twentynine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (d) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Edmondson Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (e) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Heafer Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twentynine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (f) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Horseshoe Lake Fire Department, up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (g) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Jericho Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twentynine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (h) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Marion

- Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twentynine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (i) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Proctor Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twentynine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (j) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the West Memphis Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (k) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Clarkedale Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine dollars (\$12,829), and
- (1) eight and three tenths percent (8.3%) shall be distributed to the Turrell Fire Department up to a maximum of twelve thousand eight hundred and twentynine dollars (\$12,829).
- Any balances remaining for Crittenden County following the distribution in subsections (a) through (l) of this Section, shall be distributed to active fire departments based on population."
