GROWTH OF GROSS GENERAL REVENUES; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1041

Amend House Bill No. 1041 as originally introduced:

Add Representatives Alexander, Ballinger, Barnett, Bragg, Carnine, Dale, Deffenbaugh, Farrer, Fite, Gossage, Jean, Linck, S. Malone, Mayberry, S. Meeks, Neal, Payton, Womack as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Add Senator J. English as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, line 16, delete "TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY;"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO LIMIT THE INCREASE IN GENERAL REVENUE
EXPENDITURES FROM YEAR TO YEAR; AND TO
CREATE A NEXUS BETWEEN THE AMOUNT OF
GENERAL REVENUE EXPENDITURES AND THE
GROWTH OF GROSS GENERAL REVENUES."

AND

Page 1, line 34, delete "The" and substitute "(a) The"

AND

Page 2, delete line 34, and substitute the following:

"section.

(b) The director may authorize an expenditure that exceeds the



limitation stated in subdivision (a)(4)(B) of this section if the:
(1) Governor recommends the expenditure for approval; and
(2) Legislative Council, or the Joint Budget Committee if the
General Assembly is in session, approves the expenditure."

AND

Delete SECTION 2 in its entirety, and substitute the following:

"SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July
1, 2014."
