Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1350

Amend House Bill No. 1350 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 18 through 25 and substitute:

"(b)(1) No less than seven (7) thirty (30) days before the discharge date, the Department of Community Correction shall submit notice to:

- (A) The prosecuting attorney; and
- (B) The Parole Board -; and
- (C) The county sheriff.

(2) Within thirty (30) fourteen (14) days before the discharge date, the prosecuting attorney, the county sheriff, or the Parole Board may file a petition in the sentencing court stating any reasonable objection to early discharge under this subchapter warranting the forfeiture of earned-discharge credit."
